

JC6 Covid-19 Additional 16 – 19 premium funding report

Context:

DfE guidance ⁽¹⁾ stated that this additional 16 – 19 funding was to be made available for the academic year 2020 – 21 to 'mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19)', by supporting small group tuition for targeted learners.

Learners to be targeted for this tuition are defined as those:

- who had not achieved grade 5 or above in English and / or Maths by age 16.
- who are enrolled on a 16 to 19 study programme.

Funding allocation at JC6:

Additional 16-19 premium funding budget awarded to JC6: £7,235

At JC6 the planned expenditure of the allocated funding is to be used to:

Offer smaller than usual GCSE Maths and English retake groups in the Autumn term to provide targeted support for students with less than grade 4.

Give access to GCSE Maths support for students taking BTEC L3 Applied Science with Maths grades of 4.

Allocate individual mentoring help to students who had not achieved grade 5 in English or Maths and who are identified by subject teachers for support.

Identify students meeting the criteria for funding for additional targeted small group subject support in key subjects.
